If you think of NELA as the largest plaintiffs' employment law firm in the country, consider The NELA Exchange your Intranet! Following are some of the features available on The NELA Exchange.

Sixteen Substantive Groups

The NELA Exchange includes 16 Substantive Groups, each with its own listserv and document library. You can subscribe to any Group whenever you'd like and choose how you wish to participate.

- Real Time: Receive and respond to messages as they are posted by clicking on the links in the message.
- Daily Digest: One daily auto-generated summary of the day's postings.
- Legacy: Full participation via Outlook or your email client of choice. (No need to visit The NELA Exchange.)
- No Mail: You will not receive messages sent to the Group.

New Libraries Make Sharing Documents Easier

Attachments to list messages will be automatically indexed and added to that Group's library. You can add tags to your attachments and document uploads. Tags allow for quicker sorting when returning search results. When you see a tag, simply click on it to begin searching The NELA Exchange. Documents without tags will still be included in searches, but may be toward the bottom of the results.

Get To Know Your Neighbors

NELA's online *Membership Directory* includes contact information, committee memberships, areas of concentration, and Affiliate membership. Members will also have the opportunity to provide biographical information, professional experience, and more.
